

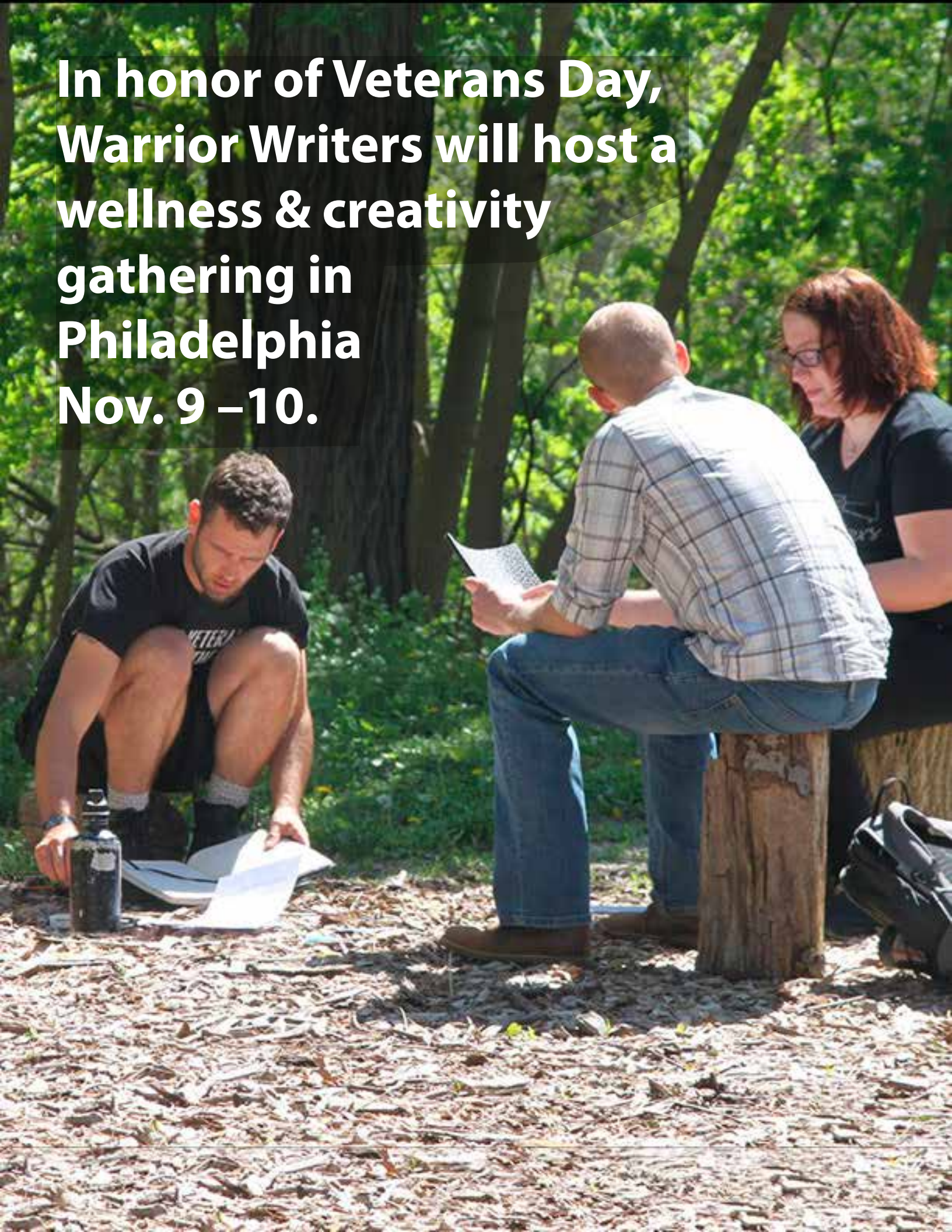

This retreat will offer veterans a sense of community & understanding with like-minded peers who have similar experiences and are interested in artistic expression.


